Golitha Falls (Golitha a'gas dynergh)

Map reference:- SX228689

Meet at 10am in the free privately owned car park of Inxies and Smoke. You can purchase drinks and food from their facility and there are also toilet facilities.

The walk to the falls is said to take about 20 minutes but I expect it could take a photographer much longer! There are many tree roots and it may be muddy on the walk to the falls so good walking shoes or boots are recommended. A climb up from the valley will lead you to an oak wood which is at least 1000 years old. There is still some evidence of the copper mining that took place here in the valley.
