Hayle sits on an estuary close to St. Ives and has a number of interesting features including a railway viaduct; a harbour; three miles of golden sands and a lighthouse; a defunct electric power station; a new quay development; churches; gardens; a new Asda and much more! If the weather is bad we can stay in our chalet, looking out over St Ives bay, and also look at your photographs – so bring some just in case!

Stout footwear is recommended and you may wish to bring slippers for chalet lounging. For lunch at the chalet, Graham will go and get some local pasties or you can bring a packed lunch. Soup, tea and coffee will be provided.

Directions

Meet at chalet B42 "Shilly Chalet" on the Riviere Towans, near Phillack. Postcode: TR27 5AF
OS map reference: SW 553 385. Please see accompanying maps

- > from the A30 roundabout east of Hayle, take the Hayle exit
- > pass the Lidl store on your right
- > continue straight over the double mini-roundabout
- > at the petrol station on your left, turn right to Phillack
- > pass the Bucket of Blood pub on your right
- > in front of the granite sign on your left "Welcome to Riviere Towans Chalets", turn left into the chalet site
(if you pass Haven Holiday Park on your right or the shop on your left, you have gone too far)
- > immediately pass the Toms Holidays office on your left
- > at the next junction, go straight on
- > at the signboard, bear left
- > then take the first right
(the track then bends right and then left)
- > at the next junction, turn right
- > once over the hill, "Shilley Chalet" is straight ahead
parking will be sorted on arrival
