2011 Members' Exhibition - Call for Entries

The Society is very pleased to continue the Members' Exhibition which was established in 2003 to commemorate the 150th Anniversary of The Society and has been held biennially since that date.

The Society supports both the art and science of photography and we hope that the final selection of 100 prints will reflect this, so as to provide a different range of work from other Society Exhibitions. The Selectors will be looking for current work from all genres and styles of photography, including science based images. Every member may enter two prints but no member will have more than one in the Exhibition. All entrants will receive a Presentation CD showing the work selected for the exhibition.

You are invited to submit entries direct, or by contacting your Regional, Group or Overseas Representatives to see if they are collecting entries from their members at a specific event. Members sending directly to headquarters are encouraged to send entries with other local members to reduce your costs and the number of packages to be handled. The sender's name, full address and number of images **MUST** be on the outside of the package. There is no entry fee but **if prints are to be returned**, members are requested to enclose return postage with their entries. **Please send stamps on a return label for UK entrants or £10 cheque or cash (15 Dollars or 10 Euros) for overseas entrants.**

2010 dates for entries, selection and notification:

- **17 September** – Closing date for UK entries to be with Regional Organisers/ Group representatives able to bring them to the Advisory Board meeting.
- **29 October** – Closing date for all other entries to be at Bath HQ
- **1 December** – Selection day
- Successful members will be notified by **17 December** and listed on the RPS website www.rps.org

2011 Members' Exhibition - Call for Entries (contd)

Council is grateful to those Regional and group Organisers and Overseas Representatives who are assisting by co-ordinating group entries. Please make their life as easy as possible by ensuring all entries are correctly labelled and accompanied by a completed entry form. If you request your representative to post your returned prints to you, you must provide suitable packing and postage (stamps on a return label).

The closing date for UK entries to be with your Regional / Group / Chapter Representative is **Friday 17 September 2010** (prior to collection at the Advisory Board meeting on 25 September). The closing date for all other entries to be at Headquarters is **Friday 29 October 2010**. Selection will take place on **Wednesday 1 December 2010**. All prints must have the name, address and membership number of the photographer, their RPS Region (or Overseas) or group and the title clearly shown on the reverse. All mounts must be **40 x 50cm**, white or off-white, no thicker than 2mm. Unmounted prints may be submitted from overseas. If possible, please send a CD with uncompressed TIFF files of your entries – 6x8 inches at 300dpi, and jpegs, max size 1024x768 pixels at 72dpi for web use.

The images entered by the photographer must not infringe any copyright or other intellectual property right of any third party. The Society accepts no liability for any breach of this rule by an entrant. The copyright of all entries remains with the entrant. The Society reserves the right to reproduce, without payment, any accepted entries in connection with the Exhibition and for publicity purposes. All images used in digital format will be of low resolution. The Royal Photographic Society will exercise all possible care to prevent the loss of, or damage to, prints submitted for the Exhibition, but does not accept any responsibility for any loss or damage, howsoever caused. Submission of an entry implies acceptance of the above regulations.

The Society is currently looking for venues for this Exhibition throughout 2011. Please contact Lesley Goode, Exhibitions Manager, if you have a suitable venue to display the 100 framed prints in your area.
