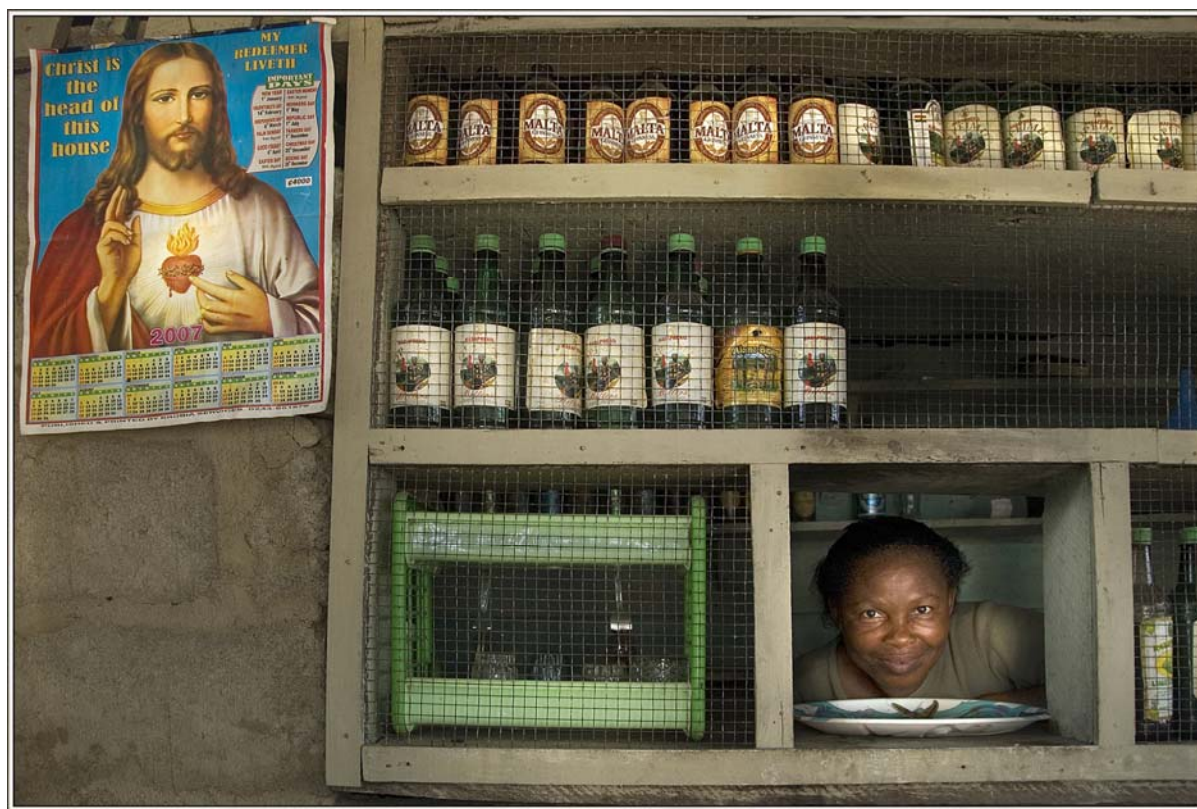


Margaret Salisbury FRPS
