

RPS East Anglia Region: Print Exhibition Rules

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY		SELECTION PROCEDURE
1	All East Anglian Members are invited to submit 4 prints, colour or monochrome (or a mixture of the two). The copyright of the entries remains with the author, but the Region reserves the right to publish in connection with the exhibition and without payment any accepted print. Prints should be mounted on 20 x 16 inch or 40 x 50cm mounts.	The Selectors will be chosen from those attending on the Selection day.
2	To enable your images to be shown on the web site or in the Newsletter please submit a copy of each image on a floppy disk or CD - images should be 6 inches on the longest side at 300 pixels per inch from best quality jpegs.	The selection jury will be chaired by the Regional Organiser.
3	If you are able, please send only recent work. New and original photographs will be given priority.	No Selector can vote for his/her own work. A reserve will stand in.
4	Work shown at any previous Regional Exhibition, will not be eligible.	Only those members who enter the exhibition will be considered eligible as possible selectors.

Please note the inclusion of the mount board size. This is to enable the prints to be transported between the venues more easily. If you particularly wish to submit images on a different sized mount board we will still accept them but it may not be possible to exhibit these images at some venues.

I would also draw your attention to the request for digital copies of your images. If you produce darkroom images and cannot produce the accompanying digital files we will copy these and include in any submission.

We will take every care but because of the public display of the images we cannot be held responsible for any loss or damage to any of the prints.
