Move it Dance is an absolute must, but register early, easy access to stage front, but over 6ft in height, consider a small step ladder! Massive crowds and loads of pap's , so find your place early, stake your claim and move around.

Carnival Del Pueblo is a must, all street dances with unlimited access to photograph dancers. The carnival celebrates all dance styles of the Spanish speaking people around the world. The South American, Brazilian dancers are fantastic to photograph. Massive crowds and loads of pap's , you will move with the carnival crowds from London Bridge to Burgess Park, just down the road from Elephant & Castle tube. The procession will take about 3hrs, therefore you will need plenty of water, limited camera equipment and plenty of stamina. Do not forget your Day Glow safety vest that states "Press Photographer" on the back

A taste of Spain is another must; many events around the streets of London, day and evening, some of the events are naturally dance events. Local London dance schools along with some of the top Spanish Flamenco dancers from Spain and all over the world attend. They literally dance in the street or on small stages, again easy access to photograph. Massive crowds and loads of pap's , so find your place early, stake your claim and move around.
