Gareth has agreed to judge our 'Bring a Print' competition. Entries can be

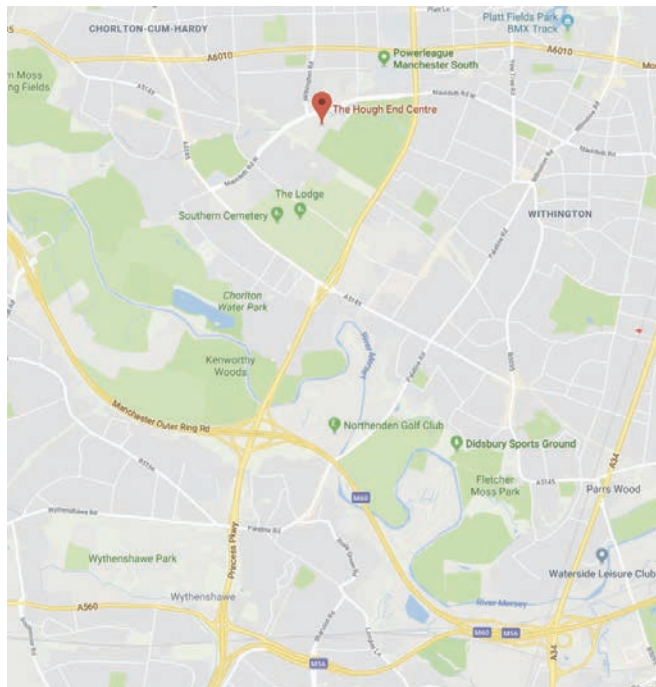
